On behalf of the Partner in Command team, we welcome you to the PiC class. If you will be arriving on Friday evening you will be providing your own dinner. The island barbecue will be available for those who wish to use it.

We will provide dinner for you on Saturday evening.

Due to the class size, you will be sterning in. When you are approaching the island, please:

- Have your stern lines ready and your rear fender in place.
- Tie your side fenders high
- Have a bow line and spring lines in place to aid in securing your boat to one beside it.

As you approach the island, call "Power Squadron Island" on channel 72 and ask for docking instructions. There will be people on the dock to take your lines and assist you. Students will moor on the north end of the dock.

You may bring your dog with you if you like. We are a dog-friendly island, but we ask that you keep them on a leash and that you bring your own bags and pick up their waste.

Please take your trash bags with you. The trash barrels on the island are for the trash after the Saturday evening dinner. We all have to take our trash with us when we leave the island.

There is no power on the island. To be considerate of all of our boaters, we ask that you turn off your generators by 10 P.M.

We will be covering anchoring during the class. Skippers are asked to inspect your equipment prior to the class to ensure that everything is in good working order.

Now that we've covered the rules....everyone seems to have a wonderful weekend on our island. We learn a lot, and also have a lot of fun. We look forward to meeting you!

Please make sure you have current insurance and a current vessel safety check. We have instructors who can inspect your vessel before our on-the-water training in the event yours is not current.
