# **Chartplotter and GPS Navigation Software**

Chart Plotter and Navigational software program for use underway or as a planning tool.

- Go to <a href="https://opencpn.org/">https://opencpn.org/</a>
- Click "Show Me More"
- Click "Download Version XXX" for your particular device of choice
- Follow prompts and download
- There are lots of How-to Manuals available
- Charts may be downloaded from <a href="https://charts.noaa.gov/RNCs/RNCs.shtml">https://charts.noaa.gov/RNCs/RNCs.shtml</a>
- For Ca Charts, click on RNCs by State/CA which will produce a CA RNCs zip file
- Save the zip file in a "Charts" folder on your computer for upload into your OpenCPN program.
- When you open the zip file, you will find a file folder "BSB ROOT". Open that and you will find all of the NOAA chart numbers.
- Select the particular chart numbers (see suggested ones below) and put them into a separate file under BSB ROOT 1 such as Ca Delta, Stockton to Monterey Bay, etc.

- When installing the Opencpn program, you will be prompted to include a chart file. Choose the file you want (either complete Ca list or the selected list you made). You can always change it in the program if you want. (Eg. Documents\Charts\Delta RNCs\BSB\_ROOT)
- Once the program has been installed and is open, go to the California area and zoom in on the area and the chart will show up.
- Now go play with all the things the program does.
