We will avoid technical terms and use only language that makes the class stress-free for you.

We will cover only the essential information and procedures to get you and your loved ones to safety.

The class is divided into two sections, classroom and on-the-water, and will cover the topics listed below. Depending on the number of students, number of instructors, and weather, the order of activities may be subject to change.

☐ How to tie your boat to the dock (Knots - cleat-hitch, clove hitch, bowline, 1/2 hitches, etc.)
Hands-on boating:
☐ Each student will go out on the water with the instructor and skipper who will act as the first mate.
