Golden Mussels	Framework implemented; active inspections at select lakes; large gaps remain; underfunded.
Marine Flares SB 561	Senate-passed; mandates manufacturer responsibility plans and collection sites
Delta Conveyance Project	Fast-track push ongoing; hearings in progress; strong opposition continues
Boater Registration Fees	No new updates publicly available
E-15 Fuel / E-10 Availability	AB 30 passed legislature; awaits governor sign; RBOC still pressing for E-10 safeguards
